

What is a pronoun?

A pronoun replaces a noun.

Example. Jane saw **herself**.

antecedent pronoun
(it comes first) (comes after)

Example. Jane got **her** mirror, and **she** looked at **herself**.

The dog nearly killed **itself** when it ran across the road.

1 st person (plural)	we	us		ourselves

We see them every day in work.

3 rd person (plural)	they	them		themselves

We see **them** every day in work.
